BIOS — 9 times in the New Testament. The period or course of life. Wealth & goods.

Mark 12:43,44 Calling His disciples to Him, He said to them, “Truly I say to you, this poor widow put in more than all the contributors to the treasury; for they all put in out of their surplus, but she, out of her poverty, put in all she owned, all she had to *live* on.”

Luke 8:14 “The seed which fell among the thorns, these are the ones who have heard, and as they go on their way they are choked with worries and riches and pleasures of this *life*, and bring no fruit to maturity.”

Luke 15:12 “The younger of them said to his father, ‘Father, give me the share of the estate that falls to me.’ So he divided his *wealth* between them.”

1Tim 2:1,2 First of all, then, I urge that entreaties and prayers, petitions and thanksgivings, be made on behalf of all men, for kings and all who are in authority, so that we may lead a tranquil and quiet *life* in all godliness and dignity.

2Tim 2:4 No soldier in active service entangles himself in the affairs of everyday *life*, so that he may please the one who enlisted him as a soldier.

1John 2:16 For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the boastful pride of *life*, is not from the Father, but is from the world.

1John 3:17 But whoever has the world's *goods*, and sees his brother in need and closes his heart against him, how does the love of God abide in him?

PSYCHE — 101 times in the New Testament. The soul-as an essence, vs. the physical body. Regarded as a moral being designed for everlasting life.

Matt 16:25, 26 “For whoever wishes to save his *life* will lose it; but whoever loses his *life* for My sake will find it. For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world and forfeits his *soul*? Or what will a man give in exchange for his *soul*?”

Matt 22:37 And He said to him, “YOU SHALL LOVE THE LORD YOUR GOD WITH ALL YOUR HEART, AND WITH ALL YOUR *SOUL*, AND WITH ALL YOUR MIND.”

Mark 8:35,36 “For whoever wishes to save his *life* will lose it, but whoever loses his *life* for My sake and the gospel's will save it. For what does it profit a man to gain the whole world, and forfeit his *soul*?”

Mark 10:45 “For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His *life* a ransom for many.”

Luke 6:9 And Jesus said to them, “I ask you, is it lawful to do good or to do harm on the Sabbath, to save a *life* or to destroy it?”

Luke 14:26 “If anyone comes to Me, and does not hate his own father and mother and wife and children and brothers and sisters, yes, and even his own *life*, he cannot be My disciple.” John 10:11 I am the good shepherd; the good shepherd lays down His *life* for the sheep. John 15:13 Greater love has no one than this, that one lay down his *life* for his friends.

1Pet 2: 11 Beloved, I urge you as aliens and strangers to abstain from fleshly lusts which wage war against the *soul*.

1Pet 4:19 Therefore, those also who suffer according to the will of God shall entrust their *souls* to a faithful Creator in doing what is right.

ZOE — 127 times in the New Testament. Absolute fullness of life, both essential and ethical, which belongs to God.

Matt 4:4 But He answered and said, “It is written, ‘MAN SHALL NOT *LIVE* ON BREAD ALONE, BUT ON EVERY WORD THAT PROCEEDS OUT OF THE MOUTH OF GOD.’”

Matt 7:14 “For the gate is small and the way is narrow that leads to *life*, and there are few who find it.”

Luke 12:15 Then He said to them, “Beware, and be on your guard against every form of greed; for not even when one has an abundance does his *life* consist of his possessions.”

John 1:4 In Him was *life*, and the *life* was the Light of men.

John 3:14-16 “As Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up; so that whoever believes will in Him have eternal *life*. For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal *life*.”

John 3:36 “He who believes in the Son has eternal *life*; but he who does not obey the Son will not see *life*, but the wrath of God abides on him.”

John 4:10 Jesus answered and said to her, “If you knew the gift of God, and who it is who says to you, ‘Give Me a drink,’ you would have asked Him, and He would have given you *living* water.”

John 6:51 “I am the *living* bread that came down out of heaven; if anyone eats of this bread, he will *live* forever; and the bread also which I will give for the *life* of the world is My flesh.”

John 10:10 “The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I came that they may have *life*, and have it abundantly.”

John 11:25,26 Jesus said to her, “I am the resurrection and the *life*; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies, and everyone who *lives* and believes in Me will never die. Do you believe this?”

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the *life*; no one comes to the Father but through Me.”

Rom 1:17 For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, “BUT THE RIGHTEOUS man SHALL *LIVE* BY FAITH.”

Rom 6:10,11 For the death that He died, He died to sin once for all; but the *life* that He *lives*, He *lives* to God. Even so consider yourselves to be dead to sin, but *alive* to God in Christ Jesus.

Gal 2:19,20 For through the Law I died to the Law, so that I might *live* to God. I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who *live*, but Christ *lives* in me; and the *life* which I now *live* in the flesh I *live* by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.

Phil 1:21,22 For to me, to *live* is Christ and to die is gain. But if I am to *live* on in the flesh, this will mean fruitful labor for me; and I do not know which to choose.

Col 3:3,4 For you have died and your *life* is hidden with Christ in God. When Christ, who is our *life*, is revealed, then you also will be revealed with Him in glory.

2Tim 3:12 Indeed, all who desire to *live* godly in Christ Jesus will be persecuted.

1Pet 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us to be born again to a *living* hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.

1John 4:9 By this the love of God was manifested in us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world so that we might *live* through Him.

Rev 21:27 nothing unclean, and no one who practices abomination and lying, shall ever come into it, but only those whose names are written in the Lamb’s book of *life*.

Rev 22:14 Blessed are those who wash their robes, so that they may have the right to the tree of *life*, and may enter by the gates into the city [the new Jerusalem].

Rev 22:17 The Spirit and the bride say, “Come.” And let the one who hears say, “Come.” And let the one who is thirsty come; let the one who wishes take the water of *life* without cost.
